### Trachycarpus fortunei



**Common name:** Chinese Fan Palm

**Height:** 6/8 meter

**Growing:** medium

**Foliage:** evergreen palm, fibrous hairy palm

**Flowers / Fruits:** yellow orange flowers in spring

**Soil:** acidic to alkaline, well-drained soil.

**Irrigation:** regular

**Hardiness:** hardy -20°C

**Long description:** Trachycarpus fortunei, also known as Chinese Fan Palm is not originally from South America. Due to it's popularity in our Asian productline, we've also put this easy to grow palm in our PatagoniaPlants website.

Trachycarpus fortunei is very cold resistant and hardy down to atleast -20°C. The fan shaped leaves can grow up to 1 meter. In it's first years, the fortunei is a slow growing palm. However, after a few years growth will proceeed rapidly. An outstanding palm to use in European garden. Easy to grow and always good for a tropical look!
