Azara microphylla



Common name: Boxleaf Azara, Corcolén, Aromo de hoja pequeña, Chinchín

Height: 3/4m

Growing: medium

Foliage: evergreen, smallest leaves of the Azara family.

Flowers / Fruits: clusters of tiny yellow flowers and creamy white berries

Site: sun to light shade

Soil: acidic to slightly alkaline, well-drained soil.

Irrigation: regular

Hardiness: hardy -10°C

Long description: Azara microphylla, also known as Boxleaf Azara is an evergreen shrub. It has fan-like branches and small dark, glossy leaves. Bears abundance of scented tiny showy pale yellow flowers. Flowers are followed by creamy white berries.
