### Ribes magellanicum



**Common name:** Uvilla, Parilla, Magellanic currant

**Height:** 1,5-3 m

**Growing:** medium

**Foliage:** deciduous, green shiny leaves.

**Flowers / Fruits:** edible dark red to black fruits and creamy white flowers.

**Site:** sun to light shade

**Soil:** acidic to slightly alkaline

**Irrigation:** regular

**Hardiness:** semi-hardy -8 -10°C

**Long description:** Ribes magellanicum also known as Magellanic currant, is a deciduous Chilean shrub originating from one of Patagonias most beautiful areas; Tierra del Fuego. Magellanic currant has shiny green leaves and bears long tassels of creamy white to yellowish flowers, followed by dark red to black edible berries.
