Common name: Antarctic Beech, Nothofagus montanei, ñirre, Nothofagus antarctica

Height: 15m

Growing: medium

Foliage: deciduous tree with small crenated leaves. Turns red in autumn

Flowers / Fruits: n/a

Site: sun

Soil: acidic to neutral

Irrigation: regular

Hardiness: -20°C

Long description: Nothofagus antarctica also known as Antarctic Beech is the most hardy Nothofagus of South America. It is a deciduous, broadly conical tree, with small oval, crinkly-edged, glossy, dark green, crenated leaves, which turn reddish - yellow in autumn.
