Height: 30m

Growing: medium

Foliage: deciduous, turns red in autumn.

Soil: acidic to alkaline

Irrigation: regular

Hardiness: -10°C

Long description: Nothofagus pumilio also known as fagus pumilio, is a deciduous tree, which turns yellowish-red in autumn. Pumilio is native to the centre of the Andes, the temperate forests of Chile and Argentina and all the way down to Tierra del Fuego!
